- Abingdon's Eric McClure was the third fastest among 51 drivers during Thursday's NASCAR Nationwide Series practice session at Daytona International Speedway.

McClure posted a time of 183.311 miles per hour in the Hefty Ford.

Due to Friday's rainout of Nationwide qualifying session, McClure will start from the No. 26 position in today's race.

Brad Teague of Johnson City was able to complete just one lap Thursday after tire problems forced his car to spin. Teague, a former driver for the Abingdon-based Henderson Motorsports team, will start from the No. 34 spot today.
